<b>Results</b>	The IJS (ISU Judging System) will be used for all Divisions. Open Marking Results displayed or announced will remain provisional until the results are certified by the segment Referee and Technical Controller on the official result form.
<b>Membership Requirements</b>	At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their State Association and an affiliated club.  Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU member skating organisation and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organisation; the membership must be valid during the full competition period.
<b>Insurance/ Liability</b>	All members of ISA Member Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover. Ice Skating Australia & Ice Skating Queensland Inc. assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event.
<b>Eligibility to Compete</b>	Skaters must have passed the relevant ISA test level at the close of entries.

<p><b>Entry Conditions</b></p>	<p>Entries will not be considered complete unless;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Completed Entry Form is received</li> <li>• Full Payment is made</li> <li>• Planned Program Content Details / Music Details / .mp3 music file and current Sports Integrity Certificates are uploaded with entry.</li> </ul> <p>* Late entries will be accepted on double the Entry Fee but will not be accepted after the Draw.</p>
<p><b>Coach Accreditation</b></p>	<p>Only coaches accredited with the Australian Coaching Council may obtain championship accreditation. In the case of an international coach who has not had the opportunity to pursue ACC accreditation, the coach may make written application to APSA <a href="http://apsa.net.au">apsa.net.au</a> seeking APSA endorsement for the provision of championship accreditation upon review of evidence of qualifications submitted in English. All coaches must have a Queensland Working with Children Blue Card.</p>
<p><b>Divisions</b></p>	<p><b>Singles:</b> Preliminary, Elementary, Adult Copper &amp; Adult Bronze  <b>Ice Dance:</b> Preliminary, Elementary &amp; Adult Bronze  <b>Synchronized Skating:</b> Juvenile</p>
<p><b>Awards/Trophies</b></p>	<p><b>Queensland Competition</b>      Trophies will be awarded to first, second and third place competitors respectively in all sections.</p>
<p><b>Refunds</b></p>	<p>Refunds shall only be considered for medical reasons, supported by a medical certificate <u>before the draw</u>. No refund permitted after the draw.      A 15% fee to cover administration costs will be deducted from the refund.</p>
<p><b>Photography</b></p>	<p>Ice Skating Queensland is a regulated organisation under Queensland's Child Protection laws. As such, filming or photographing any minor, without the express permission of the parents or legal guardians of the child, is prohibited. For private photographers, please note that no flash photography is permitted in practice, warm-ups or events, as it may be dangerous to the skaters.</p> <p>On-line Photography is the official photographer at the event. <p><b>Music Provision &amp; File Naming</b></p>	<p>Music files must be uploaded at time of entry. Uploaded music must be named as per ISA Music Provision Protocol.  <a href="#">ISA Music Provision Protocol V1</a></p> <p>All competitors' coaches must have on hand at the event, a backup copy of their skater's competition music <b>on USB</b>. The USB must contain only one track and must be marked as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Competitor's name.</li> <li>• Event Section, e.g. Junior Women</li> <li>• Program identification, e.g. Short Program</li> <li>• Exact running time of the music (not skating time)</li> </ul> <p>Mobile phones will NOT be accepted for backup use.</p> <p>Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs &amp; Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction.</p> <p>Each program (short program, free skating, short dance, free dance) must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music. The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of the competition. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or reused.</p>
<p><b>PPC / Music Forms</b></p>	<p>Planned Program Content, Music Details and current Sports Integrity Certificates must be uploaded at time of entry.</p>

**The Frank Family Trophy – QFSC**

Established by the Frank Family in 1983 for Artistic Presentation in Free Skating, this Trophy will be awarded to the competitor(s) in the Championships who provides the most artistic presentation of a skating program. Skaters in all divisions will be considered and voted on by the Championship Judges to determine the winner.

**The Morgan Innes Perpetual Trophy – QFSC**

A Perpetual Trophy of Excellence was established in 2007 in memory of Morgan Innes, a young ISQ skater who tragically died in a boating accident in Sydney. The Morgan Innes Trophy of Excellence will be awarded annually to the first placed skater participating in either the Single Ladies or Single Men's divisions at the Queensland Figure Skating Championships (Pre-Primary – Senior) with the highest overall total points score margin between first and second place. In the event that two skaters have the same winning margin, then the skater with the highest margin in the free skating event shall be awarded the trophy. If this margin is the same then the skaters will share the trophy.

**The Queensland Achievement Award – QFSC**

This Trophy is an encouragement award donated by Ann Short – Shorbrite Australia. The Trophy will be awarded for the highest points achieved overall at the Queensland Figure Skating Championships in the Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice & Intermediate Divisions in Singles & Pairs.

**The Coates Family Trophy – QFSC**

The Coates Family Trophy was donated by Joan Coates and is given to the 1<sup>st</sup> Placed Senior Dance Couple at the Queensland Figure Skating Championships.

**The Ray Patterson Shield – QFSC**

The Ray Patterson Shield is given to 1<sup>st</sup> Placed Junior Dance Couple at the Queensland Figure Skating Championships.

Note: All perpetual trophies will be retained by ISQ and will be engraved with the winner's name. Perpetual trophy winners will receive a substitute trophy to keep.
