Supporting statement from Hugh Peterken

I would like to present my credentials in support of my nomination to the position of Treasurer of Ice Skating Queensland

My approach as Treasurer

If I am elected to the Board, my focus will be in making sure that the finances of ISQ are properly aligned with the needs and wants of the members. I would like to ensure that investment decisions are transparent to members and have their support. ISQ needs a long-term financial strategy that provides value to members and strengthens ice skating in Queensland. I intend to leave day to day financial operations to Iceworld's capable professional staff.

Ice skating

I am an active ice skater, making regular use of ISQ facilities at Boondall and Acacia Ridge. I started skating as an adult and currently compete in both Synchronised and Ice Dance disciplines. I also have 2 children who skate and have competed at a high level (in Figure and Synchronised). My experience therefore includes recreational skating, competitive skating and parenting elite skating children.

Not for profit Boards

I currently sit on two ISQ sub-committees – the Governance Committee and the Facilities Committee (where I am Secretary). I previously held the role of Treasurer for the Iceworld Figure Skating Club.

I have a long history of service on not for profit Boards, including 3 years as President of the Board of The International Institute of Business Analysts – an organisation of 2000 members. I have also held the roles of Chairman for The Institute of Electrical Engineers Australia Branch, Secretary of The Kamusi Project focused on preserving African languages and Council delegate on Queensland Council of ICT Associations.

Business Acumen

I have had a successful career in industry, running large departments with budgets of up to \$25M per annum and up to 110 staff in multiple countries. I have worked in Australia and overseas and I have been internationally recognised for my contributions to industry. I ran my own consulting business in Business Analysis for several years. This broad experience of business, along with an ability to apply professional tools, positions me well to understand the current operations of ISQ and to model opportunities for change.

In summary, I believe that I have the experience and the drive to fulfil the role of Treasurer of Ice Skating Queensland, and I ask for your vote.
